## Integrated Water Action Plan presented to GMDA by GuruJal

22nd October 2020

This association with GMDA aims at enabling better recharge, reuse, water revenue and flood management strategies.

## Groundwater Recharge and RWH Retrofitting Proposals submitted this month

19th October 2020

Groundwater Recharge Proposal for Tauru Block has been submitted to District Administration Nuh this month. Proposal for Retrofitting and Repairing of RWH has been submitted to Municipal Corporation Gurugram (MCG). The first draft of the Flood Management Action Plan has also been submitted to MCG.

## Damdama Biodiversity Park survey completed this month

27th October 2020

To study the biodiversity park area GuruJal team has completed the reconnaissance survey of the area. Pre-study of the area has started to understand the local people dependency on the Aravalli hills and identifying the local species of the region.

**Door to Door Dependency Survey** - GuruJal team conducted door to door survey (90 households) in Damdama village to know the dependency of the villagers on the Pahad area where Biodiversity Park is to be constructed.

**Sampling** was done in Aravalli hills of Damdama village to plot sample for vegetation assessment and identify the dominant species.
