Khentawas village pond was selected for restoration & rejuvenation under 'Support A Pond' initiative of GuruJal Society. In order to treat the entering wastewater in the pond and to provide clean water for groundwater recharge, a decentralized wastewater treatment plant of Advanced Eco-Reactor Technology of 150 KLD capacity has been constructed.
