Site visit with Haryana Pond & Wastewater Management Authority

11th February 2022

Meeting was held under the chairmanship of Executive Vice Chairman of Haryana Pond and Wastewater Management Authority, various progress and steps ahead for the next financial year to be taken ahead were discussed. District work needs to be reviewed, action plans to be shared and discussed from ULBS and PRI's to be updated from PDMS. PDMS needs to incorporate water testing reports of the pond which have been already restored.

Team GuruJal visits Damdama for plant specimen collection

18th February 2022

GuruJal team members on 18/02/2022 along with interns from I.P. University visited Damdama, to collect specimens from plants and trees to prepare herbarium. 35 different plant specimens were collected from different types of trees and shrubs. Herbarium is basically a collection of dried and pressed plant part which gives knowledge about the flora of the region.

Household Survey of waste management practices conducted at Dhaura



Glimpse from house-hold survey in village Dhaura

1st February 2022

GuruJal team conducted a household survey to figure out waste management practice in village Dhaura. 40 households were surveyed and it was observed that there is no space for dumping waste. 82% of the respondents segregate their waste and over 85% have issues due to lack of dustbins and kachra-shed. No collection of waste is done from the households. Major issues come with clogging of waste in the in-let to the pond, the drains are not covered and hence it gets clogged with waste that is a nuisance. Also, excessive ash from the 'chulhas' are getting in the drains and the pond which apparently makes the pond water blackish.
